Answer: the ‘Holy infant’ Jesus

Carol: *Hark! the Herald Angels Sing*

Answer: “Glory to the new born King,
peace on earth, and mercy mild,
God and sinners reconciled!”

3. Why do we sing ‘Joy to the world’?

Carol: *Joy to the World*

Answer: the Lord is come! the Saviour reigns!

4. Who ‘laid down his sweet head’?

Carol: *Away in a Manger*

Answer: ‘the little Lord Jesus’

5. ‘What can I give him, poor as I am?’

Carol: *In the Bleak Midwinter*

Answer: ‘what I can I give him: give my heart’

6. Where are all the ‘faithful’ to come?

Carol: *O Come, All Ye Faithful*

Answer: Bethlehem

7. What shines in the ‘dark streets’ of a little town?

Carol: *O Little Town of Bethlehem*

Answer: ‘the everlasting light’

8. What once stood in ‘royal David’s city’?

Carol: *Once in Royal David’s City*

Answer: a lowly cattle shed, where a mother laid her baby

9. Who were ‘following yonder star’?

Carol: *We Three Kings*

Answer: three kings from the Orient bearing gifts

10. What happened when ‘the angel of the Lord came down’?

Carol: *While Shepherds Watched Their Flocks*

Answer: glory shone around
